The cost of this event will be \$45 dollars in advance and \$60 at the door (if there is still space available). - 1 bottle of 2005 Art Series Leeuwin Estate Chardonnay approx value \$85
- 1 Magnum Sojourn Cabernet approx value \$150
- 1 bottle Presidio-Artist License Pinot, and Syrah as well as their Chardonnay approx value \$130
- 2 bottles of 2005 Lewis Cuvee blend (very hard to find) approx value \$250 per bottle
- 1 bottle of 2004 Araujo Eisele Cabernet approx value \$250
- 1 signed Magnum of Buttonwood Blu estate blend approx value \$75
- 1 bottle of Addamo Chardonnay and one bottle of their Syrah approximate value \$70
